A LOCAL LAW CHANGING TO A FOUR YEAR TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE TOWN TAX COLLECTOR

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the
(Name of Legislative Body)

County City Town Village

of NEWCOMB as follows:

Section 1. Intent, Authority – The purpose of this Local Law is to permit the Town of Newcomb to change the term of office of the Town Tax Collector (Receiver of Taxes and Collections) from two years to four years. It is adopted pursuant to New York Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10.

Section 2. Change of terms of office – The term of office of the Town Tax Collector (Receiver of Taxes and Collections) is hereby changed from two years to four years commencing with the term which begins January 1, 2014.

Section 3. Repealer; Supersession – All Local Laws or Ordinances or parts of Local Laws or Ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local law are hereby repealed. In particular, this Local Law is intended to supersede that portion of New York Town Law Section 24 which provides for a two year term of office.

Section 4. Severability – The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph or provision of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other clause, sentence, paragraph or part thereof.

Section 5. Effective Date – This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State.


